

Confirmation Culmination Ceremony




This ceremony is celebrated by the Confirmandi and their families. Our Catholic faith is rich in symbolism which is what this ceremony celebrates. It is about passing on the faith to the next generation.

Families gather with the Confirmandi in celebration using the symbols of:

- Water which reminds us of our Baptism.
- Candle which symbolizes how we are to carry the light of Jesus into the world.
- Oil which represents the anointing that our ancestors received when they were chosen by God to continue His work.
- Cross which represents the sacrifice of Jesus sacrificed because of His love for us. It reminds us that we, too, may have to make sacrifices as we follow our faith.
- Church We are the Church and each of us brings our own special gift that will build it up.

This ceremony is a moving and wonderful way to bring full circle the Confirmation preparation that these young people have performed. It is also recommended that right after the program the students receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation in preparation for Confirmation.
